# Funding educational buildings

Schools and colleges are designed for intense use, but the inevitable wear and tear means buildings will always need to be maintained, upgraded and sometimes expanded. Funding is available to help

Condition Improvement Funding (CIF) is a government program that is operated to enable academies and sixth-form colleges to apply for funding (annually) to keep buildings in good working order where students and teachers can thrive.

The fund helps education providers address health and safety concerns, building compliance issues and deteriorating conditions. Academies, sixth-form colleges and non-diocesan VA schools rated good or outstanding by Ofsted can also seek expansion funding if they can justify specific needs.

# Help with the bidding process

Arcus helps educators identify and prioritise estate requirements ahead of any bidding process. This could involve condition surveys and building assessment, right through to project completion.

Getting the bid right can save time and ensure successful applications. Our experienced project managers support you every step of the way during planning and project design.

We undertake all required surveys, cost management tasks, then support the bid writing process and submit applications on behalf of clients.

Multi-Academy Trusts (MATs) with at least five academies, and more than 3,000 pupils, do not apply for CIF. Automatic funding occurs in the form of School Condition Allocation (SCA). In such cases, Arcus assesses and prioritises all necessary works required for immediate and future needs. This maximises the benefits to your estate.

# Understanding the CIF process

Education professionals have significant milestones every academic year. We make understanding the CIF process straightforward so that no key funding dates are missed.

Funding application windows can vary each year, but the CIF process does follow a similar timeline every twelve months.

Updated funding information is usually released in October. New applicants should register by the end of November and submit completed forms by mid-December. Notification of application outcomes occurs the following spring.
